



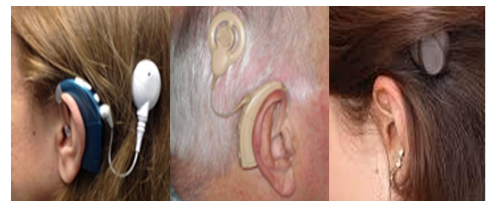
Northern Cochlear Implant Social Group Sheffield Venue
